## BACKGROUND

At the sustainable development summit on 25 September 2015, UN Member States adopted the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development, which includes a set of 17 Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) and 169 targets to end poverty, fight inequality and injustice, and tackle climate change by 2030. The SDGs replace the Millennium Development Goals (MDGs), which were adopted by the United Nations in September 2000 to reduce extreme poverty. The SDGs are universal, integrated and interlinked, and implementation of the SDGs rests with individual countries.

The Govt. of India is currently working on the larger picture of SDGs, i. e. how to translate each individual aspect of SDG into the govt. programs and policies. The NITI Aayog, who is providing the overall coordination and leadership, has carried out a detailed mapping of the 17 Goals and 169 targets to Nodal Central Ministries, Centrally Sponsored Schemes and major government initiatives. Most state governments have carried out a similar mapping of the SDGs and targets to the departments and programmes in their respective states.

It is widely believed that global problems have local solutions. With 65% of the SDG indicators relevant to local authorities, the effective implementation of Agenda 2030 and SDGs depends on the local ownership and involvement of various stakeholders at local level. The urban goal of SDG is Goal no. 11 which focuses on 'making cities and human settlements inclusive, safe, resilient and sustainable'. This can only be achieved through effective partnership between all urban stakeholders including public sector, private 'make cities and human settlements inclusive, safe, resilient and sustainable' and civil society at local level. In order to equip the local level decision makers to understand & implement SDG 11, it is important to impart training to develop the right Knowledge, Attitude and Skills. Sensitizing urban professionals about achieving SDGs is the need of the hour, and is also at the heart of the New Urban Agenda of Habitat III.

In this context, this 3-day training programme on 'Achieving the Sustainable Development Goals- The Way Ahead' organized by HUDCO's HSMI during 25-27 September 2019 at Chandigarh will explore strategies and tools for implementation of SGDs at local level through classroom presentations, brain storming sessions and group activities. It offers an opportunity for exchange of ideas and information among urban professionals on issues, challenges, strategies and approaches associated with achieving Sustainable Development Goals in general and Goal 11 in particular.

## PARTICIPATION

The key stakeholders at state/ local level involved in planning and implementing policies, programme and strategies crucial for implementation of SDG Goal 11 are proposed to be trained in the programme. These include:

- State Urban Development Departments
- Town Planning Agencies and development authorities.
- Urban Local Bodies
- Academic Institutions in urban development
- Policy Professionals
- Sustainable Development Practitioners
- Other relevant stakeholders

## PROGRAMME OBJECTIVES

The training is intended to help participants increase their knowledge, equip them with innovative tools and know-how for designing and implementing appropriate policies, approaches, programmes and intervention with respect to SDGs. Major objectives of the training programme are as follows:

- To impart knowledge on SDGs, with focus on Goal 11
- To equip participants towards approach road to SDG implementation at local level by developing suitable Actions Plans for localizing SDGs.
- To familiarize the participants with the indicators for monitoring SDGs progress and reporting its achievement.
- To develop capacity building strategies for key stakeholders for implementing SDGs.

## PROGRAMM CONTENT

The series of modules will introduce the SDG framework & particularly the localization of SDG 11. The programme is intended to help the participants to develop the understanding and framework for localizing the Sustainable Development Goals. The contents of programme are as follows:

- Role of cities and human settlements in achieving sustainable development and setting local SDG Agenda.
- Planning & Implementation framework and strategies for achieving SDGs.
- Formulating Action plan for achieving SDGs
- Cross goal linkages to achieve multiple goals and targets.
- Financial Imperatives for achieving SDGs
- Short & long term governance reforms at local level along with the policy framework.
- Monitoring & Evaluating SDG outcomes
