The first page of the article should include: i) the paper's title; ii) a 200-words abstract that emphasizes the paper's contribution to the field and its practical architectural/ planning/ social/ economic implications; iii) the name(s), position(s), professional or academic affiliation(s), and email ID (s) of the author(s), as well as the full postal address of the corresponding author.
3. Please ensure that references are complete, have been arranged alphabetically by author surname and checked for accuracy.
4. Figures/Tables/ graphs used in the article should also be sent in high resolution files separately along with source files. Proper caption and source should be mentioned.
5. Declaration that the paper/article is neither published nor under consideration for publication elsewhere.
